I-78 West to I-287 North to Exit 22B (Rte 206 North). Proceed north to 6th traffic light, turn left (Rte 512 aka Pottersville Rd.). Go approximately 3/4 mile to School House Lane, turn left, after the third speed bump the USET headquarters are on the right.

From South

I-287 North to exit 22B (Rte 206 North). Then follow above directions.

From North

From West

CLASSES WILL BEGIN AT 10 am

For Beginner classes (horse or rider), schooling attire permitted.
Riders may exhibit in historical habits in any class.
Junior riders must wear protective head gear when mounted.

Beginner Rider - All Seats – Schooling Attire Permitted.

1. Leadline- Open to riders not reaching their sixth birthday as of 12/31/09.
2. Walk and Trot both ways of the ring.
3. Walk and Trot both ways of the ring, may be asked for extended trot.

Beginner Horse -All Seats – Schooling Attire Permitted.

4. Walk and Trot both ways of the ring, and stand quietly.
5. Walk and Trot both ways of the ring, extended trot.

Open Pleasure -All Seats – Historic Habit Permitted

6. Pleasure. Walk, Trot and Canter both ways of the ring, stand quietly and back.
7. Bridle Path Hack. Walk, Trot and Canter both ways of the ring, extended trot, stand quietly and back.
8. ***\$500 Open Pleasure Stake – Sponsored by Mary Beth Walker*** All seats. Walk, Trot and Canter both ways of the ring, extended trot, stand quietly and back. **Horses must be entered in at least one other class within this division. Entry Fee \$35.**
1st \$155; 2nd \$120; 3rd \$85; 4th \$55; 5th \$45; 6th \$40.

Open Equitation on the Flat-All Seats – Historic Habit Permitted

9. Open Equitation. Walk, Trot and Canter both ways of the ring.
10. Open Equitation. Walk, Trot & Canter both ways of the ring, & Rising Trot.
11. Open Equitation. Walk, trot and canter, both ways of the ring. Individual test, not to exceed 2 minutes demonstrating all 3 gaits on both reins, all exhibitors will ride the same test, to be posted on Sunday morning. Turn out 15%.

AGE OF ELEGANCE TURNOUT AWARD.

Award recipient to be selected from the entrants in the Open Equitation Division, without regard to seat ridden. Judged independently on the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance. The winner of this class is awarded the Age of Elegance Award.

Victorian Ladies-Side Saddle through the ages. Historic Habits Required.

12. Obstacle Class. Individual test to be posted prior to the class, may be asked to walk, trot and negotiate obstacles familiar in the ring or on a trail.
13. Pleasure. Walk and Trot both ways of the ring.
14. TP Pairs Class. Command Class for side saddle pairs that will be supplied with an eight foot length of toilet paper. Last pair that keeps the TP intact will be the winner. May be asked to walk, trot, halt, back and change directions.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) It is a condition of entry to the showground's that these rules and regulations and those of the USEF are read, understood and accepted.
- 2) Entry fee: \$15.00 per class, except the Pleasure Stakes Class. Entrants will also be charged a \$10.00 office fee per rider. Entries close July 15, 2010. Post entries are subject to a \$20.00 per horse fee.
- 3) Refunds on entries will be made only on receipt of a Veterinarian's certificate. An office-processing fee of \$20.00 will be deducted from all refunded entries.
- 4) Limited stabling is available. Stalls are 12' x 12'. All arrangements for stalls must be made through Shelly Liggett at 908-722-3665 or MMLMom@aol.com. May be combined with Camp Leaping Horn arrangements.
- 5) Eight ribbons will be awarded in each class. High Point and Reserve ribbons will be awarded as described.
- 6) A copy of a negative Coggins test, dated within one year of the show, **MUST** be submitted with entry. Health certificate is required for out-of-state horses.
- 7) Protective headgear is strongly recommended at all times while mounted. It is compulsory for riders in all classes, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear, which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. **Junior riders must wear protective headgear when mounted.**
- 8) **Prize Money:** All prize money will be paid through the show office. All prize monies in excess of balance due will be mailed to the owner of record, unless otherwise directed, within 30 days after the completion of the show.
- 9) Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- 10) Show management shall decide all questions not covered by the rules in this prize list.
- 11) **The USET, Camp Leaping Horn and the Liberty Side Saddle Network, its owners, officers, operators, employees, volunteers or show management will not be responsible for any accident, injury, loss or mishap which might occur at this show to any person, animal or property of exhibitors or spectators. This applies to all days from July 22 though 25 2010.**
- 12) Ring Size: Approximately 125' x 260'. Footing- Sand.
- 13) Horse and Rider combinations in classes 1 through 5 are limited to those classes and class 12, 13 and 14.
- 14) **"All Seats"** means the class is open to Hunt Seat, Stock Seat and Saddle Seat aside riders. Either the trot, jog or intermediate gate, etc. is acceptable in these classes.
- 15) Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes as entries warrant.
- 16) **ATTN EXHIBITORS:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooter, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
